Kings District RCMP Crime Stats and Crime Trends Monitor

For May 2024

Activity Synopsis:

Persons crimes for May increased from 28 in April to 46. Uttering threats and indecent/harassing communications both were tied for 12 occurrences, followed by eight assaults. Of the assaults, two were cleared by charge/charge recommended, while two others are open/still under investigation. The remaining occurrences are concluded for various reasons. There were seven sexual offences reported in May, and all were concluded but for one that is open/still under investigation.

There were 69 property crime occurrences for the month, down from 49 in April. Mischief (28) and fraud (19) accounted for most of the activity again this month. There were three break and enters were reported, with two occurrences open/still under investigation (no charges have yet been laid). Additionally, two arsons were reported, one of which was concluded with insufficient evidence. The other occurrence resulted in charges laid against a suspect who was arrested shortly after the incident occurred.

Two drug enforcement files were recorded. No charges were laid in either occurrence.

Traffic occurrences accounted for 258 occurrences in May, down from 287 in April. There were six impaired driving occurrences reported, with charges laid/recommended in two of the four alcohol occurrences. The other occurrences, including a single impaired by drug and by a combination of alcohol and drug, were concluded without charge. Speeding violations accounted for 74 occurrences, with an additional 132 other traffic violations/offences. Six Checkstops were documented in May.

Overall, 579 occurrences were recorded with 553 of these being founded or still under investigation. This is lower than the same month last year (614 / 584 respectively), but higher than last month, when 537 occurrences were recorded with 511 as founded or SUI.

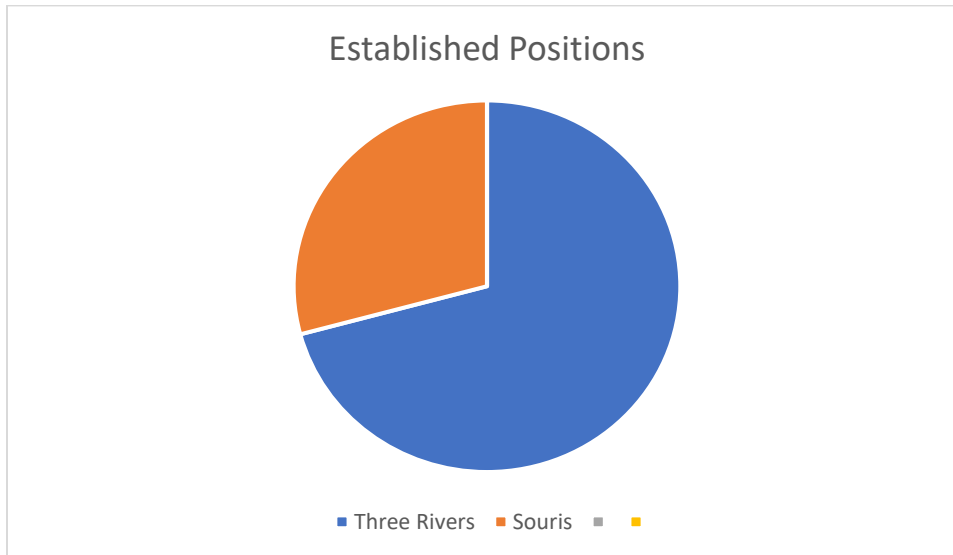
