## Kings District RCMP Crime Stats and Crime Trends Monitor

For October 2024

### Activity Synopsis:

Persons crimes accounted for 23 occurrences in October, up only one occurrence from September. Assault accounted for nine of the occurrences, with three concluded with charges laid/recommended and two open/still under investigation. Four sexual offences were reported, with all four currently open/still under investigation.

Property crime dropped to 61 occurrences, down from 70 in September. Mischief accounted for 34 occurrences, to which two have been cleared by charge/charge recommended. Four break and enter occurrences were reported, with three open/still under investigation. There were two thefts of motor vehicles reported in September, and both were concluded with insufficient evidence to proceed.

A single drug enforcement occurrence was reported (trafficking). The matter was concluded with insufficient evidence to proceed.

Traffic occurrences accounted for 221 occurrences, up only a few from September. Impaired driving accounted for nine occurrences. Six of these were by alcohol (three cleared by charge/charge recommended), and three by drug (one cleared by charge/charge recommended and one open/still under investigation). Speeding violations accounted for 79 occurrences, and other traffic offence/violations accounted for 96. No fatal collisions were reported. There were four Checkstops documented.

Overall, 515 occurrences were recorded with 488 of these being founded or still under investigation. This is on par with October 2023, when 518 occurrences, with 494 founded/SUI, were reported. This is lower than September 2024, when 552 occurrences, with 523 founded/SUI, were reported.

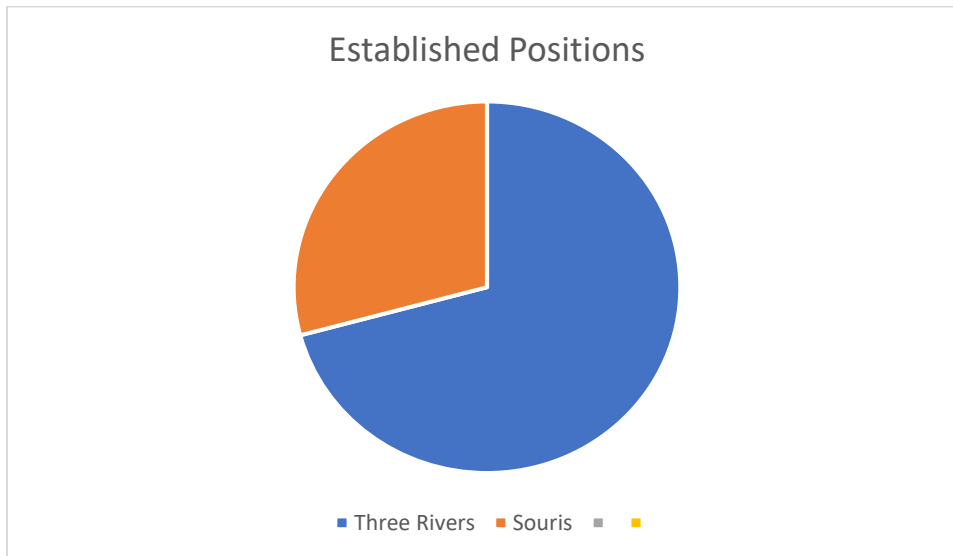
