# Police Activity

## Occurrence Summary

January ended the month with 10 persons crimes reported. Of these, two were sexual offences (both open/still under investigation) and three were assaults (one remains open/still under investigation). The remaining activity was in the uttering threats category, with two concluded by charge laid/recommended.

Property crime accounted for 38 occurrences in January, with 30 occurrences split equally between mischief and fraud. Of these only one file, involving stolen checks, will be proceeding to charges laid/recommended. Many of the fraud occurrences involved online scams. A motor vehicle was reportedly taken in January; it was determined to be a civil matter between the parties looking to sell and purchase the vehicle.

A single drug investigation was conducted, as a complainant/victim reported that she believed she was drugged by individuals known to her. The file was concluded due to a lack of evidence.

Traffic occurrences accounted for 134 incidents in January. There were three impaired driving occurrences, two by drugs and alcohol combined, and one by drug alone (which is open/still under investigation). A single failure/refusal also resulted in charges laid/recommended. Speeding violations accounted for 23 occurrences, with 73 other traffic offence/violations. There were no fatal collisions in South Kings in January. Seven Checkstops were documented during the month.

Overall, 305 occurrences were recorded with 299 of these being founded or still under investigation. This is lower than January 2024, when 327 occurrences (with 313 founded/SUI) were reported, and December 2024 (last month), when 356 occurrences, with 341 founded/SUI, were reported.



# Community Policing

## Policing Initiatives

- An individual that posed significant challenges for the Kings area had been targeted previously and subjected to a search warrant and arrest in Queens District in relation to drug trafficking. This led to a 58 month jail sentence, weapon prohibition and forfeiture of seized property. This was a collaborative effort of the former Kings RCMP street crew and Provincial GIS.

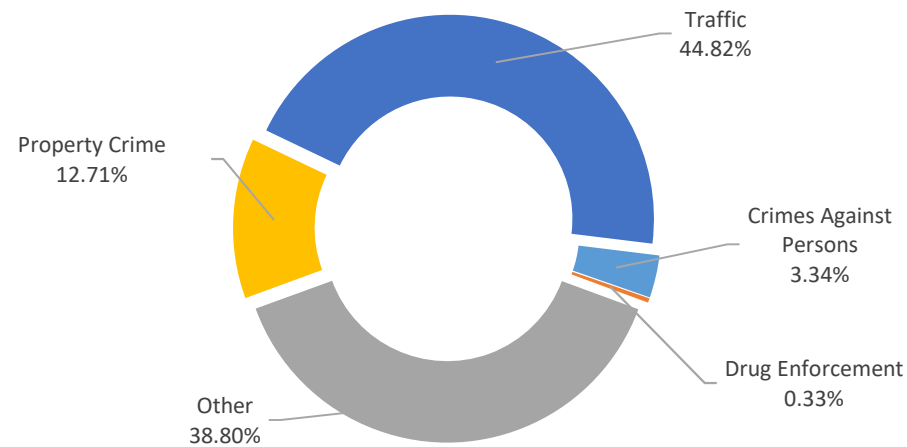
## Selective Traffic Enforcement Program and Checkstops

- 2025-01-01 – Route 4 – Brudenell – Vehicles checked for various infractions, two warnings issued
- 2025-01-01 – Route 1 – Mt Mellick- 75 vehicles checked, 5 mandatory breath demands all reading 0
- 2025-01-01 – Route 2 – St. Peters - No infractions uncovered
- 2025-01-02 – Route 326 – Valleyfield – Vehicles checked for speeding and expired inspection decals. No violations noted
- 2025-01-02 – Route 5 - Lake Verde - No infractions uncovered
- 2025-01-07 – Route 4 – Commercial Cross – 1 driver refused blood demand for THC
- 2025-01-10 – Route 16 – Kingsboro – No infractions uncovered
- 2025-01-12 – Route 5 – Avondale - No infractions uncovered
- 2025-01-16 – Route 3 & Route 1 – Pooles Corner to Cherry Valley – Speed enforcement, 100 vehicles checked with none travelling above the posted limit, including the 70 KM/H zone in Vernon River.

- 2025-01-17 – Route 1 Route 26 – Impaired driver check with none identified
- 2025-01-20 – Route 2 Rollo Bay – 30 vehicles checked with 2 violation tickets issued

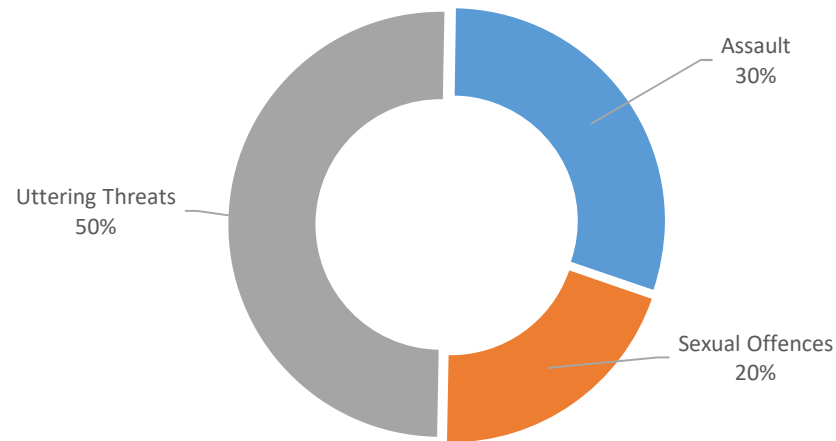

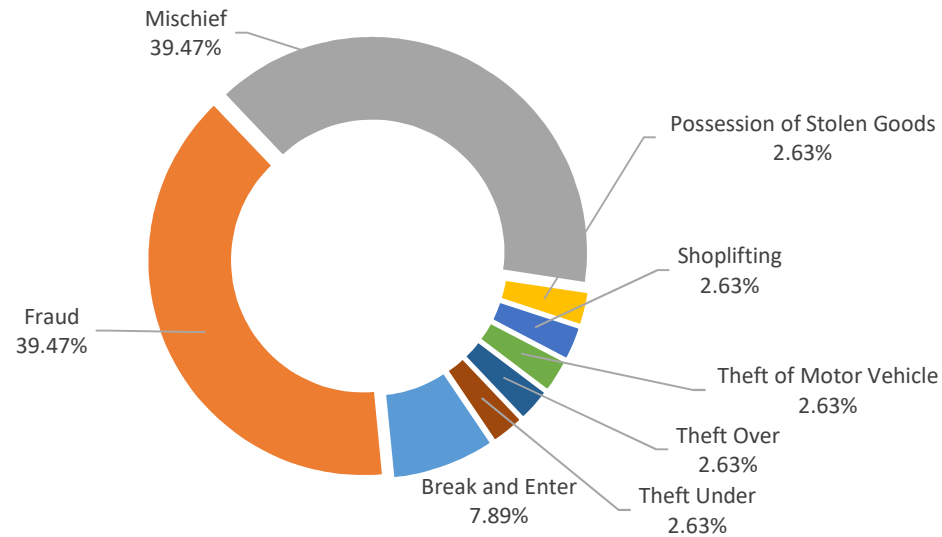


10 Founded/SUI of 305 Total Occurrences

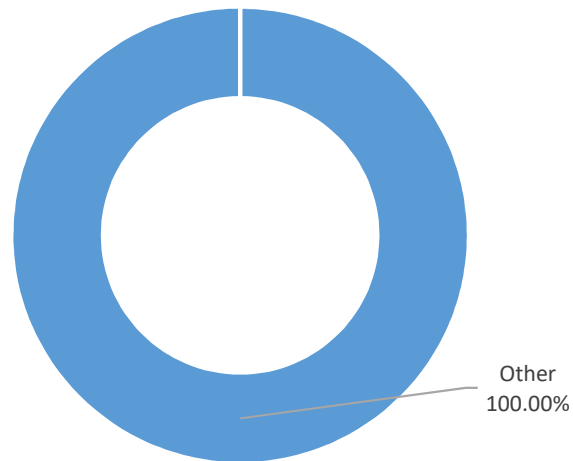

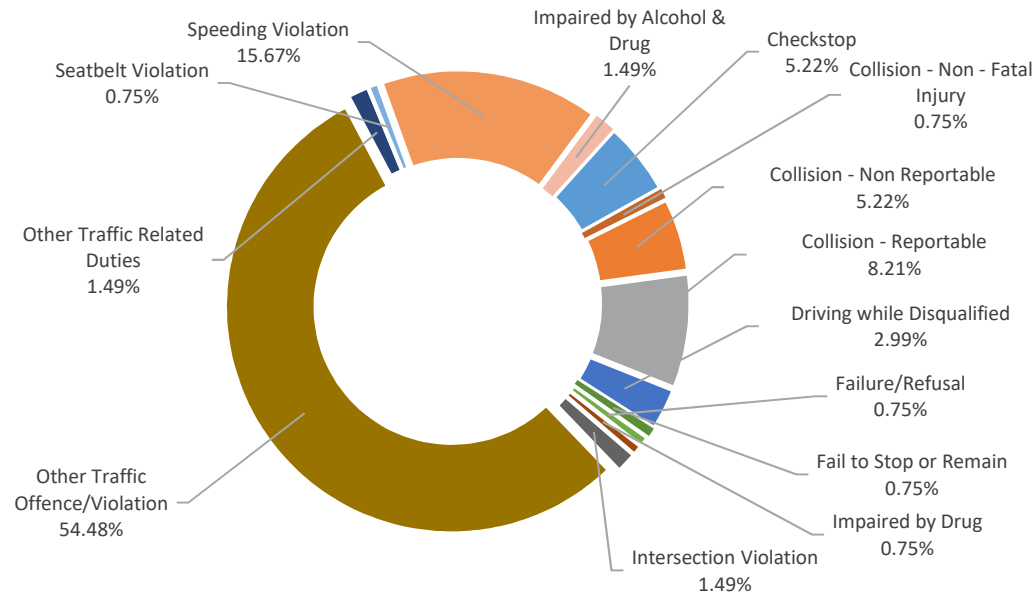

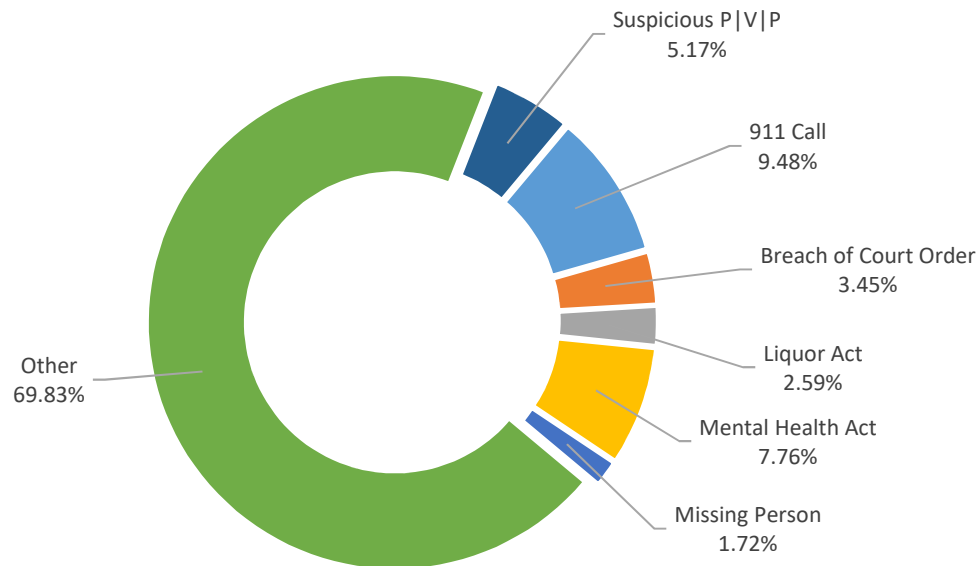
