Police Activity

Occurrence Summary

There were 19 occurrences recorded in April, down from 22 in March. Assaults accounted for seven of the occurrences, with charges laid/recommended in four and two remain open/still under investigation. A single sexual offence was also recorded, which is open/still under investigation. Criminal harassment and indecent/harassing communications each accounted for four, with three uttering threats. No charges were laid/recommended in any of these occurrences.

Property crime accounted for 33 occurrences, down from 42. Mischief was the most frequent occurrence, with 18 recorded. A single break and enter is still open/under investigation. The remaining activity included theft under \$5000 (5 with charges laid/recommended in one), fraud (3), theft from motor vehicle (2), shoplifting (1), possession of stolen goods (1) and unlawfully in a dwelling house (1)

A single drug enforcement occurrence (non-criminal) was reported in April.

Traffic enforcement occurrences increased to 183 for April, up from 152 in March. Impaired driving accounted for six occurrences; all alcohol based. Charges were laid/recommended in four of these occurrences, with the remaining two occurrences concluded with insufficient evidence to proceed. A single failure/refusal (to provide a sample) was also recorded and solved as non-criminal. There were 39 speeding violations reported, and 87 other traffic offence/violations. There were no fatal collisions in April, and CheckStops and STEP files were recorded.

Overall, 390 occurrences were recorded with 379 of these being founded or still under investigation and a total of 538 occurrences were recorded in all of Kings District. South Kings 390 occurrences is higher than April 2024, when 369 occurrences (with 348 founded/SUI) were reported, and last month, when 354 occurrences, with 337 founded/SUI, were reported.



Community Policing

Policing Initiatives

An individual was arrested and charged for arson to a residence in Murray Harbour, they remain in custody awaiting court disposition. Kings' members also performed 3 curfew checks, arrested 2 individuals on outstanding warrants and monitored 3 people released after incarceration that included post release visits and we partnered with the Parole Board to monitor 3 subjects in the community or provide disclosure to assist with their decisions. Kings RCMP also began efforts to participate in the Souris Regatta Festival scheduled for July and to attend a ceremony to unveil a statue for Fisher's lost at sea in Murray Harbour in May in addition to having attended Ringette in Montague, completing school visits and hosting RCMP recruiting talks in Kings District. Members were also provided with training in Emergency Medical Response Training, Intelligence Collection, Crisis Negotiation, Peer to Peer Support and Supervision.

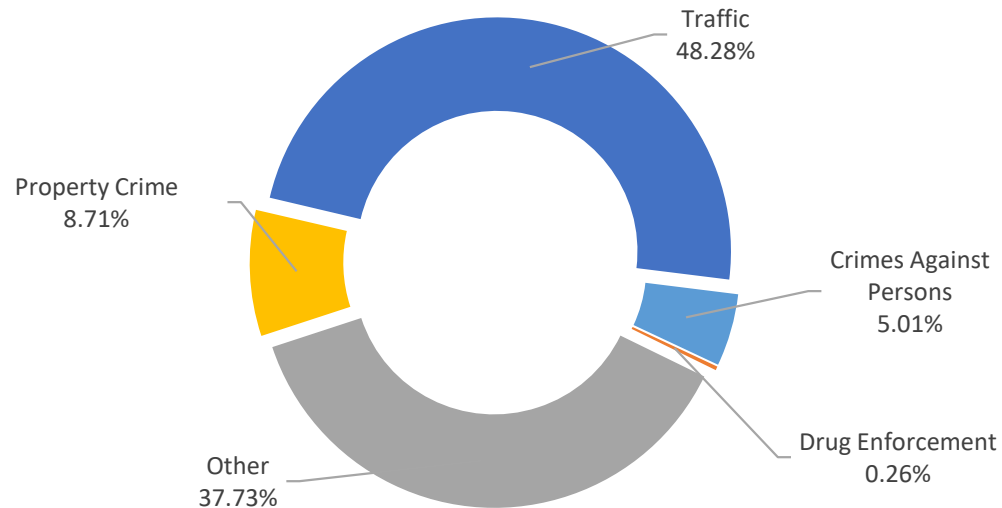
Traffic Enforcement

- 13 checkstops were completed in Glenwilliam (Apr 1), New Perth and Watervale (Apr 4), Montague (Apr 5), Souris (Apr 11), Vernon Bridge (Apr 14), Georgetown and Murray River (Apr 15), Pisquid West (Apr 17), Murray River x 2 (Apr 18), Roseneath and Baldwin Road (Apr 21).
- Hundreds of vehicles were checked during the checkstops and only minor traffic offences were observed ranging from verbal and written warnings to summary offence tickets.
- 6 specific traffic enforcement occurrences were completed Main Street Montague (Apr 16), Princess Drive Montague (Apr 22), Route 3 from Pooles Corner to Cherry Valley (Apr 23 and 29), Route 3 from Pooles Corner to Georgetown (Apr 30).
- Hundreds of vehicles were observed and assessed for speed and school bus safety and during each effort all vehicles were noted to be operating properly.

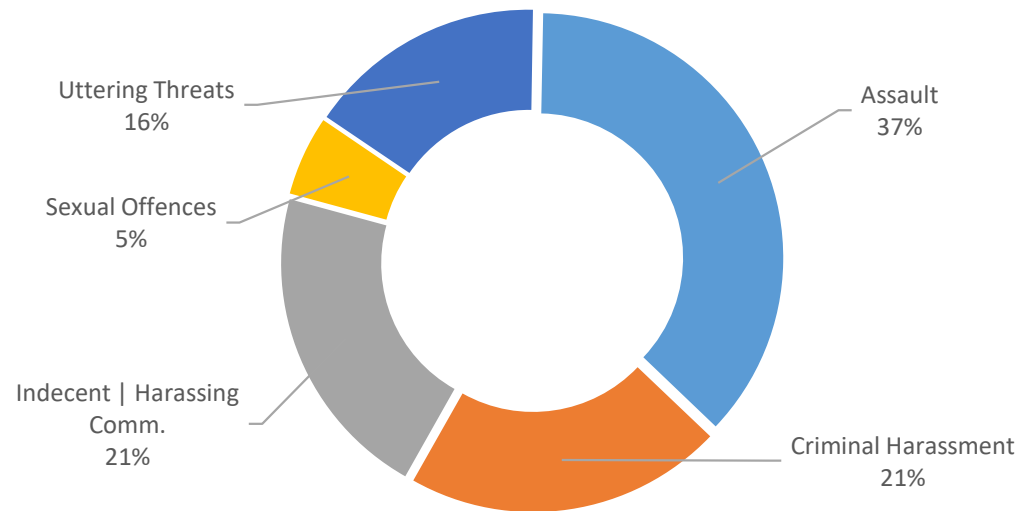


379 Founded/SUI of 390 Total Occurrences

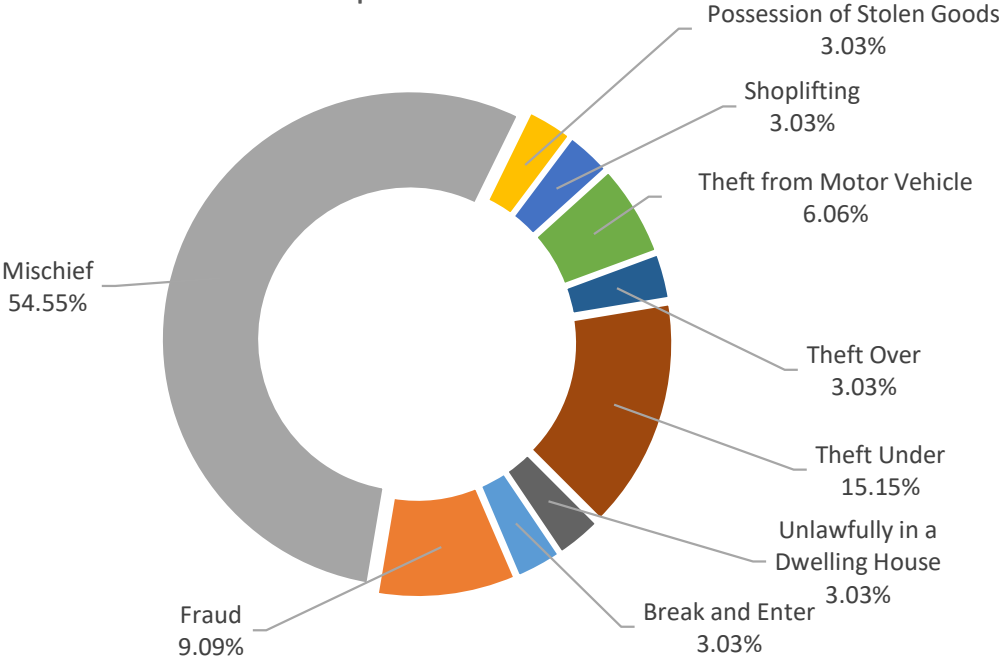


19 Founded/SUI of 390 Total Occurrences

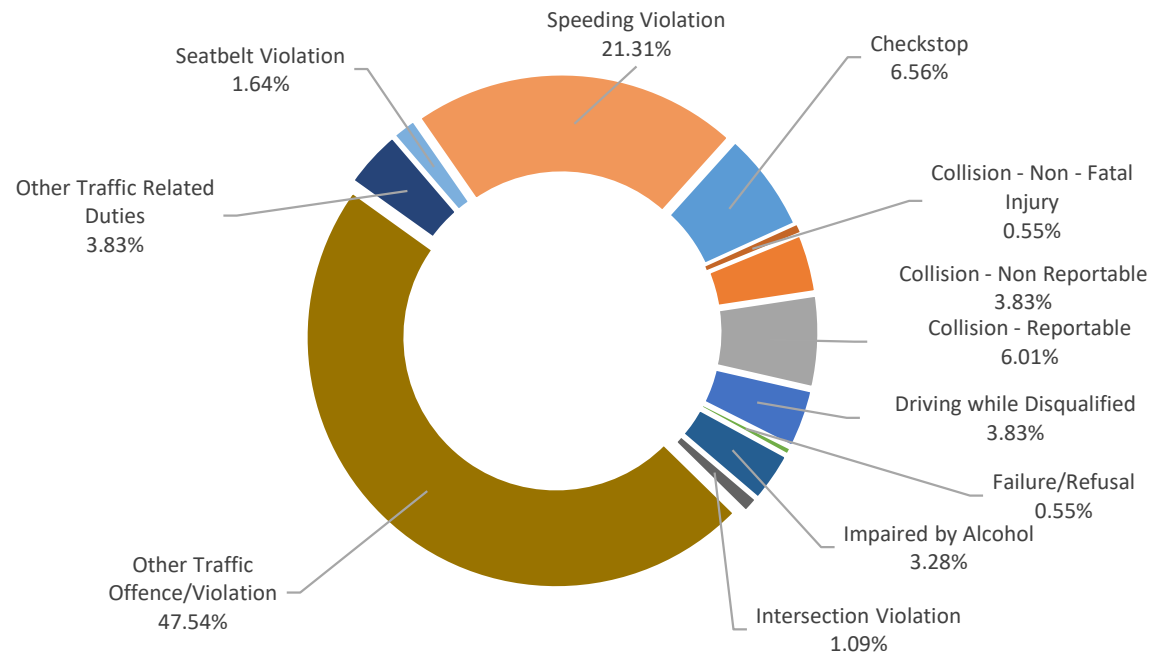


33 Founded/SUI of 390 Total Occurrences

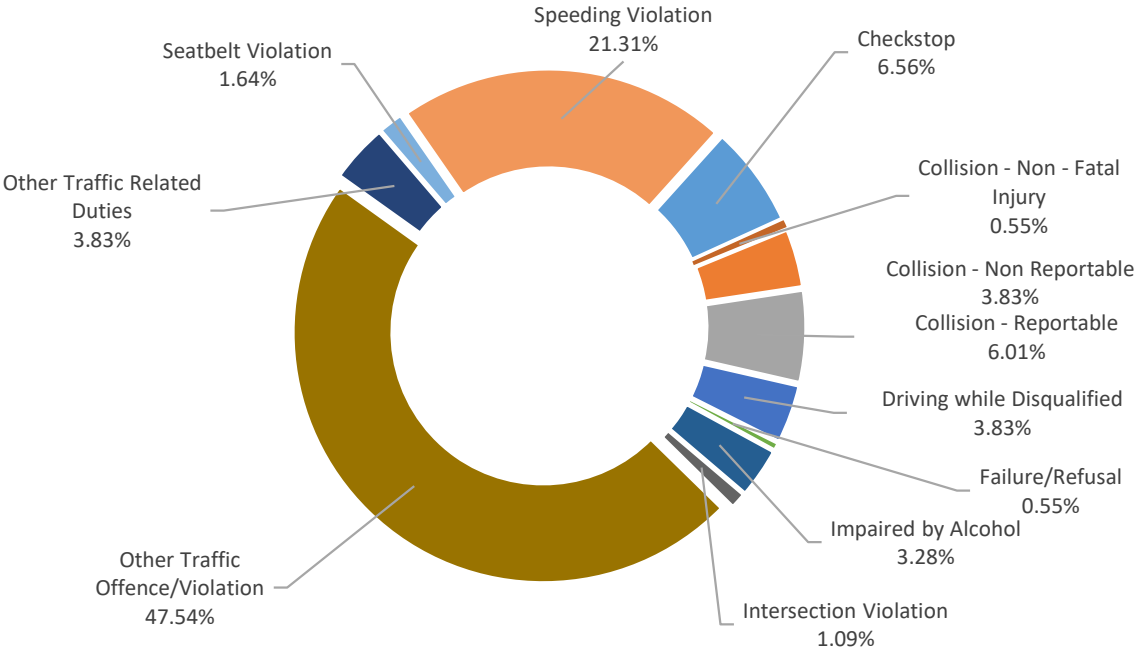


183 Founded/SUI of 390 Total Occurrences
