Fire Prevention Recommendations for Barbeque Use

- Never use a BBQ inside, including garages or closed in porches.
- BBQs should be used a minimum of 10 feet away from combustibles including buildings, decks, and mulch.
- Keep BBQs clean by removing grease and fat build up.
- BBQs should only be used on a stable and solid surface.
- Never leave your lit BBQ unattended.
- Ensure any used charcoal or other heated material have been properly extinguished and cooled before properly disposing of.
- For other than one- and two-family dwellings, outdoor cooking appliances, grills, or other similar devices intended for cooking, heating, or any other purpose shall not be used, kindled, or stored on any balcony, under any overhanging portion, or within 10 ft (3 m) of any structure.
