# Police Activity

## Occurrence Summary

Persons crime remained consistent with November, ending December with 18 occurrences. Assault was the most frequent with seven (three resulting in charges laid/recommended), followed by indecent/harassing communications and uttering threats, both of which had four each. There were two sexual offences (with charges laid/recommended in one), and one criminal harassment files, which was concluded with charges laid/recommended.

Property crime rose slightly in December, increasing to 39 occurrences, up from 34 last month. A single break and enter to a commercial property occurred, concluded with insufficient evidence. There were 19 mischief occurrences and seven frauds, followed by theft under \$5000 with five.

There were no drug enforcement occurrences opened in December.

Traffic occurrences accounted for 145 occurrences, down from 172 in November. Speeding violations accounted for 32 occurrences, with 54 other traffic violations/offences. Six impaired driving occurrences were reported, four by alcohol, one by drug, and one by a combination of alcohol and drugs. Of these, one of the alcohol-based occurrences resulted in charges laid/recommended, with another open/still under investigation, and each of the drug and alcohol/drug occurrences are open/still under investigation. There were no fatal collisions in December, and 8 Checkstops were documented.

Overall, 360 occurrences were recorded with 344 of these being founded or still under investigation. This is higher than last month, with 355 occurrences, of which 334 were founded/SUI. The month is also higher than December 2024, when 356 occurrences, with 341 founded/SUI, were reported.



# Community Policing

## Policing Initiatives

- In December Kings RCMP responded with the SRO in South Kings to investigate a threats file that extended over two different schools and three students, and another assault in a separate occurrence involving separate individuals. Kings also investigated a school lockdown in North Kings where an arrest was made for an individual causing concern to students and staff, the individual was also investigated for impaired driving and held in custody. The school lockdown proved successful until the subject was arrested. Kings RCMP also engaged in a search for an individual unlawfully at large in St Peters who had cut his ankle monitor but was later located, arrested and held in custody. In Uigg Kings RCMP entered into a search for a missing person using a drone and police dog in addition to ground search efforts to locate them and we also responded to an impaired vehicle collision in Mount Mellick with a young passenger in the vehicle although no injuries occurred. Two subjects were convicted and received jail on impaired driving offences, one alcohol one Cocaine in the Head of Cardigan and in Souris respectively and a shoplifting conviction in Montague also resulted in jail. A male in Souris was convicted of drug trafficking and is awaiting sentencing while the individual reported last month causing Mischief to the Georgetown Courthouse was sentenced to jail. Disqualified drivers were located in Montague, Milltown, Victoria Cross, Wood Islands, Cardigan, Morell and Fortune Bridge. Kings members also conducted two targeted checks and partnered with electronic monitoring to confirm compliance in Panmure Island, Montague, Brudenell and Murray Harbour. Finally, we made time to attend community events in Bridgetown Montague, Murray River, Georgetown and Souris in addition to delivering Radar training to two new members.

## Traffic Enforcement

- Checkstops were completed in Bridgetown (Dec 6), Baldwins Road (Dec 6, 31), Victoria Cross (Dec 6, 11), St Mary's Road (Dec 7), Morell (Dec 18, 22), Green Meadows (Dec 18), Bridgetown (Dec 24), Souris, Cardross (Dec 29), Cardigan, New Perth (Dec 31) – Over 500 vehicles were checked, summary offence tickets and warnings were issued and no detection of impaired driving occurred.
- Dec 6 - Main Street, Montague – Checking for distracted driving (cell phones). No violators noted and Route 3, Vernon River – High traffic flow. Traffic obeying speed limit. No violators noted
- Dec 7 – Route 318, St. Mary's Road – Checkstop conducted near residence of investigation target. Two warnings issued
- Dec 12 – Route 24, Caledonia – General traffic enforcement. Verbal warning issued for headlights off during nighttime hours
- Dec 28 – Main Street, Montague – Stationary radar enforcement, no violators observed
  
- The provincial traffic unit conducted 10 traffic patrols to Three rivers and 11 to Souris in December

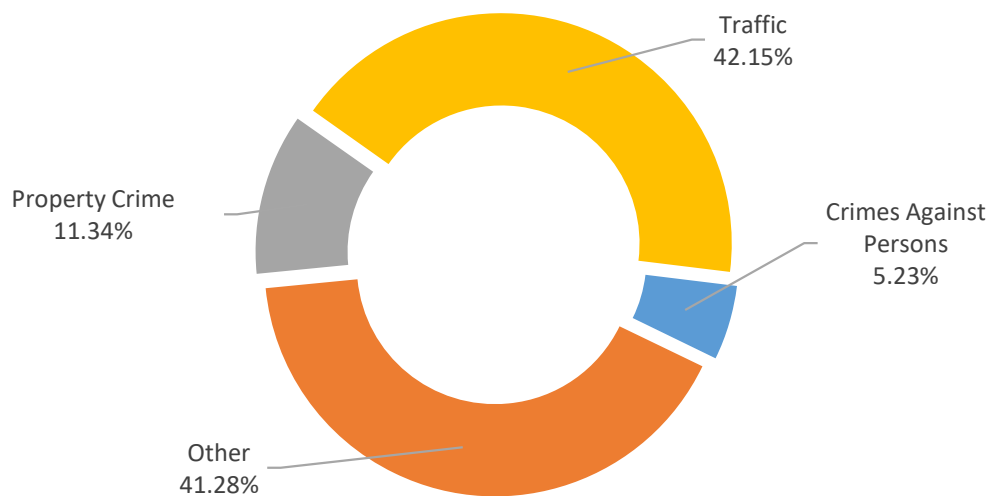

December 2025

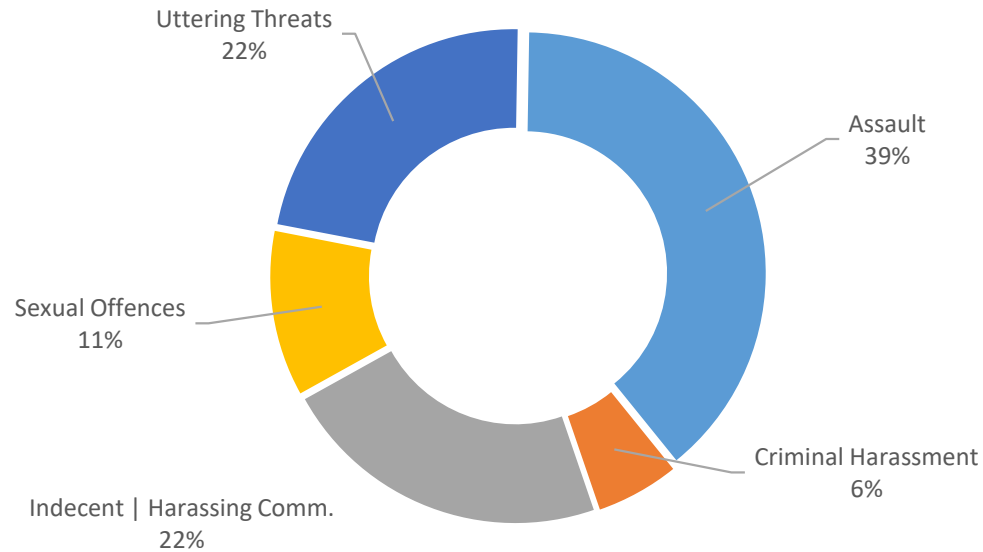


344 Founded/SUI of 360 Total Occurrences

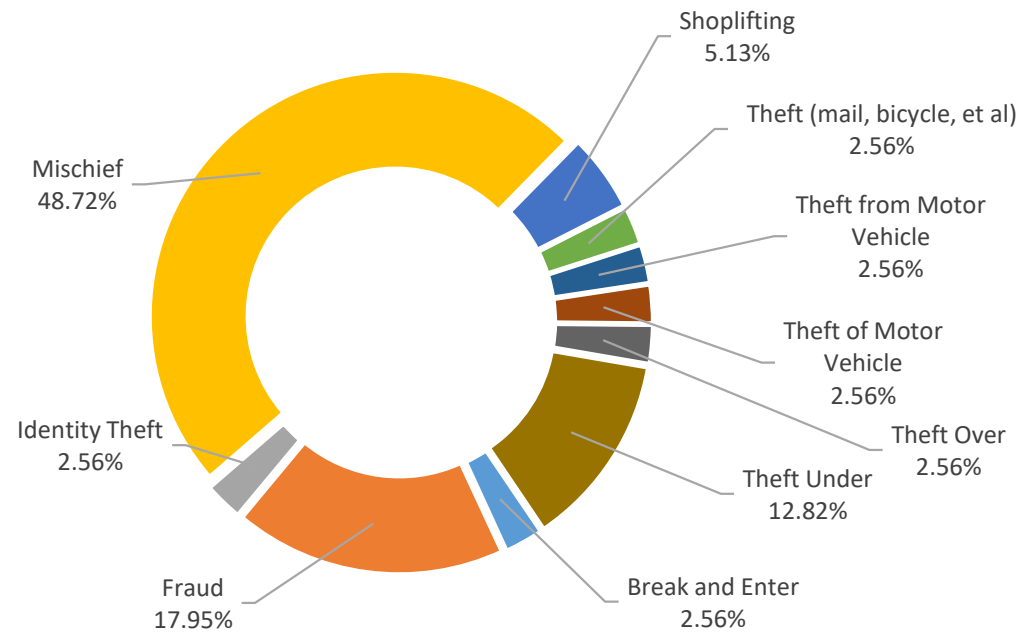


18 Founded/SUI of 360 Total Occurrences

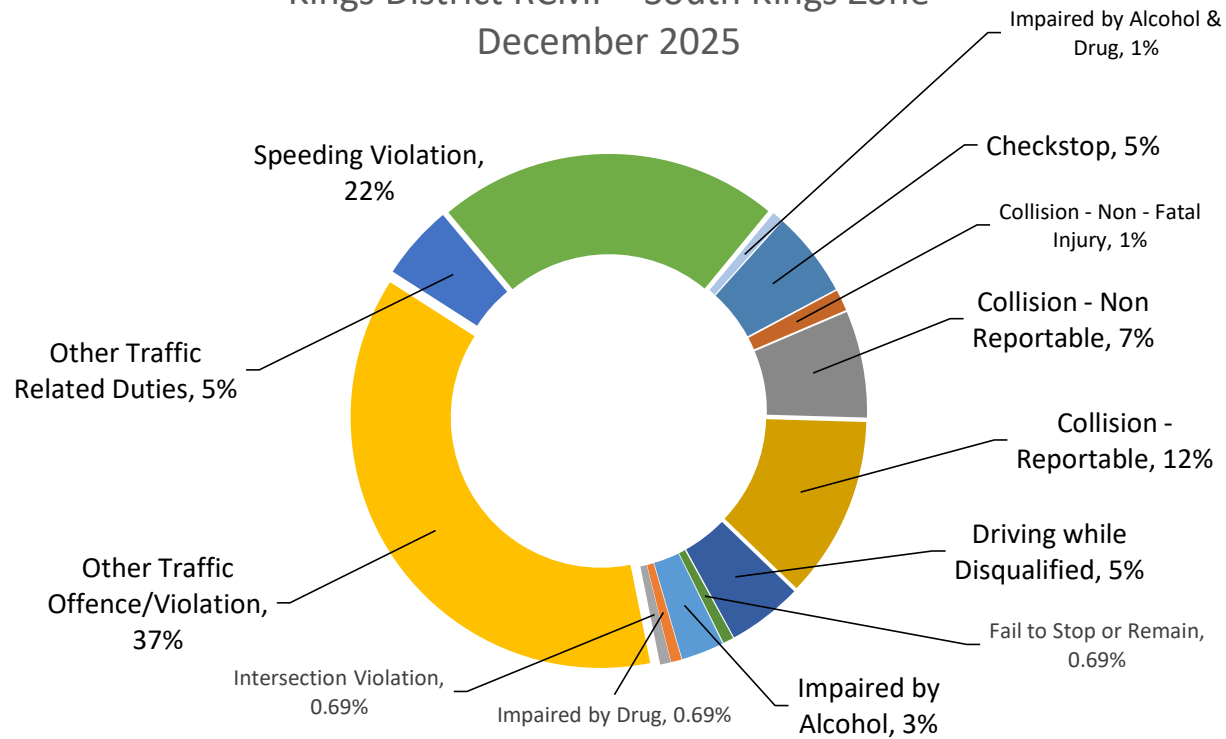

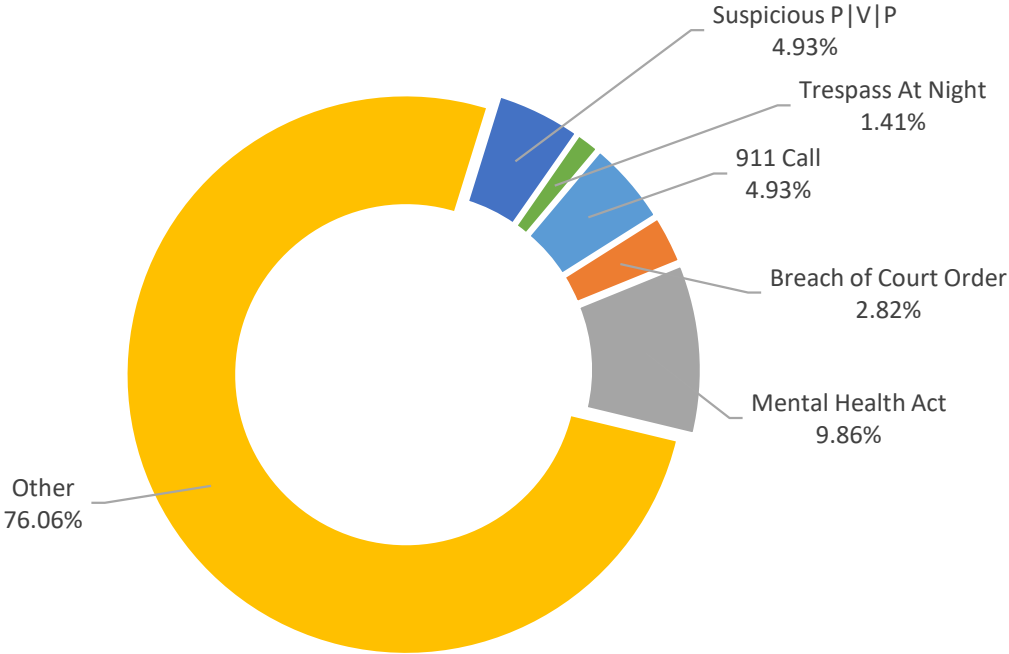
