Police Activity

Occurrence Summary

Persons crime remained consistent with December, ending January with 18 occurrences. Uttering threats was the most frequent category with six (one resulting in charges laid/recommended), followed by indecent/harassing communications (5) and assault (4). There were two sexual offences, both sextortion cases, with the complainant declined to proceed in one.

At 28, property crime decreased compared with both last month and last year (both 40). There were 13 mischief occurrences and six frauds, followed by three theft of motor vehicle incidents. A single break and enter to a commercial property occurred, with the investigation continuing.

There were no drug enforcement occurrences opened in January. This is consistent with both last month and last year (0 and 1 respectively).

Traffic occurrences accounted most of the incidents recorded in January, with 177 incidents. This is up from both last month and last year (146 and 135). The largest increases occurred in speeding violations at (55, +22 and +34 over last month/last year) and Other Traffic Violations (68, +54 over last month). Ten impaired driving occurrences were reported, seven by alcohol, one by drug, and two by a combination of alcohol and drugs. Of these, six were cleared by charge / charge recommended. There were no fatal collisions in January, and five Checkstops were documented.

Overall, 354 occurrences were recorded with 345 of these being founded or still under investigation. This is consistent with last month, with 364 occurrences, of which 348 were founded/SUI. The month is higher than January 2025, when 307 occurrences, with 298 founded/SUI, were reported.



Community Policing

Policing Initiatives

- In January while attempting to intercept an impaired, the subject collided with a Kings RCMP vehicle causing minor damage. No one was injured and the driver was charged with refusal to provide a breath sample-which carries the same penalty as impaired driving. Kings also investigated a theft of motor vehicle from Montague which was used to collide into a convenience store in Mount Stewart, one male has been charged. The vehicle was recovered in Summerside. In Montague Kings also responded to a lock down at KCMH and nearby buildings to assist CPS, with a threats investigation that originated from Charlottetown to ensure everyone's safety while CPS arrested the subject of complaint. Three individuals were convicted of an assault that occurred in Montague, and were sentenced each to jail in addition to an impaired driving conviction that saw an adult female receive 5 days jail and a large fine. Disqualified drivers were located in Canavoy, Montague and Vernon Bridge and impaired drivers were located in White Sands, Summerville, Montague, Roseneath, Iris, Head of Cardigan and St Peters Bay. Kings RCMP also partnered with Parole to assess compliance of four individuals. Finally, six members recertified on Operational Skills and made time to attend community events in Belfast, Vernon River, Montague, Souris and Georgetown and deliver a fraud presentation to seniors

Traffic Enforcement

- Checkstops were completed in Roseneath (Jan 10), Cardigan, Bridgetown (Jan 20), Souris (Jan 21), Bridgetown, Lake Verde, Mount Stewart (Jan 23), Vernon River (Jan 27) – Over 200 vehicles were checked, summary offence tickets and warnings were issued in addition to select focus on school zones and snowmobilers at crossings.
- Jan 1 - Souris Line Road, Souris – New Year's Eve patrol focus was placed on visible parties to deter impaired driving;
- Jan 10 – Route 1, Orwell – focus on speeding;
- Jan 10 – Route 3, New Perth - focus on speeding;
- Jan 22 – Route 3, Lower Montague – focus on speeding;
- Jan 22 – Route 3, Dingwells Mills – focus on inclement weather and safe driving.

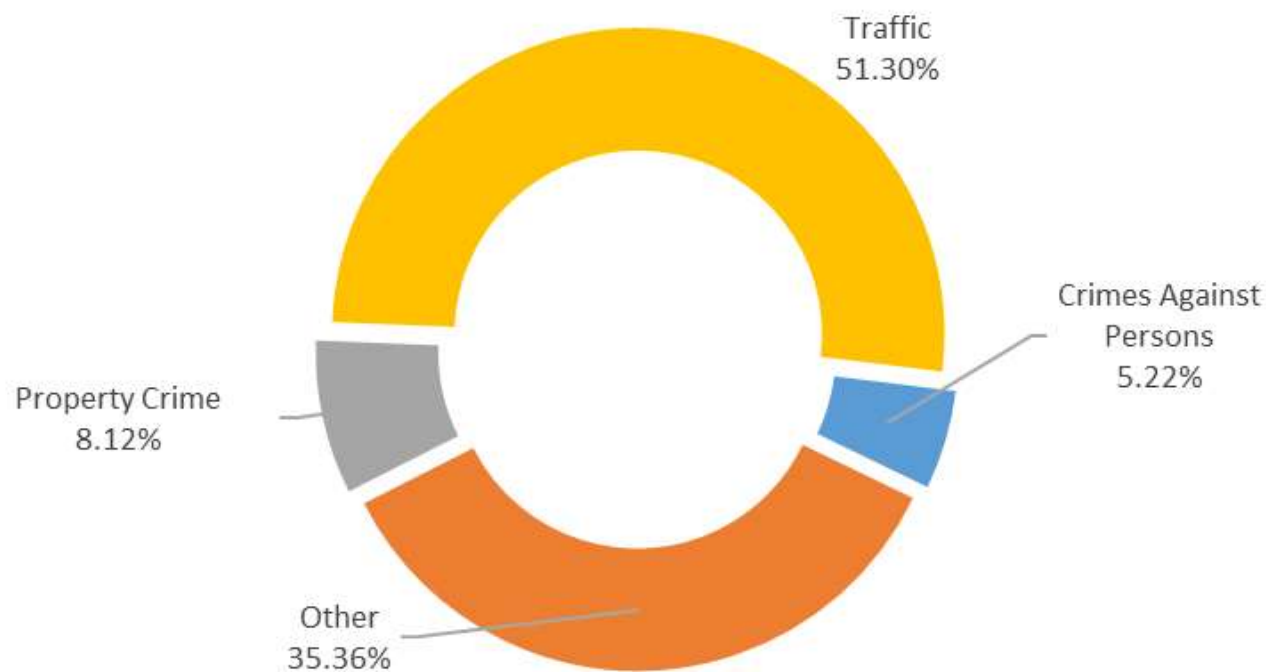

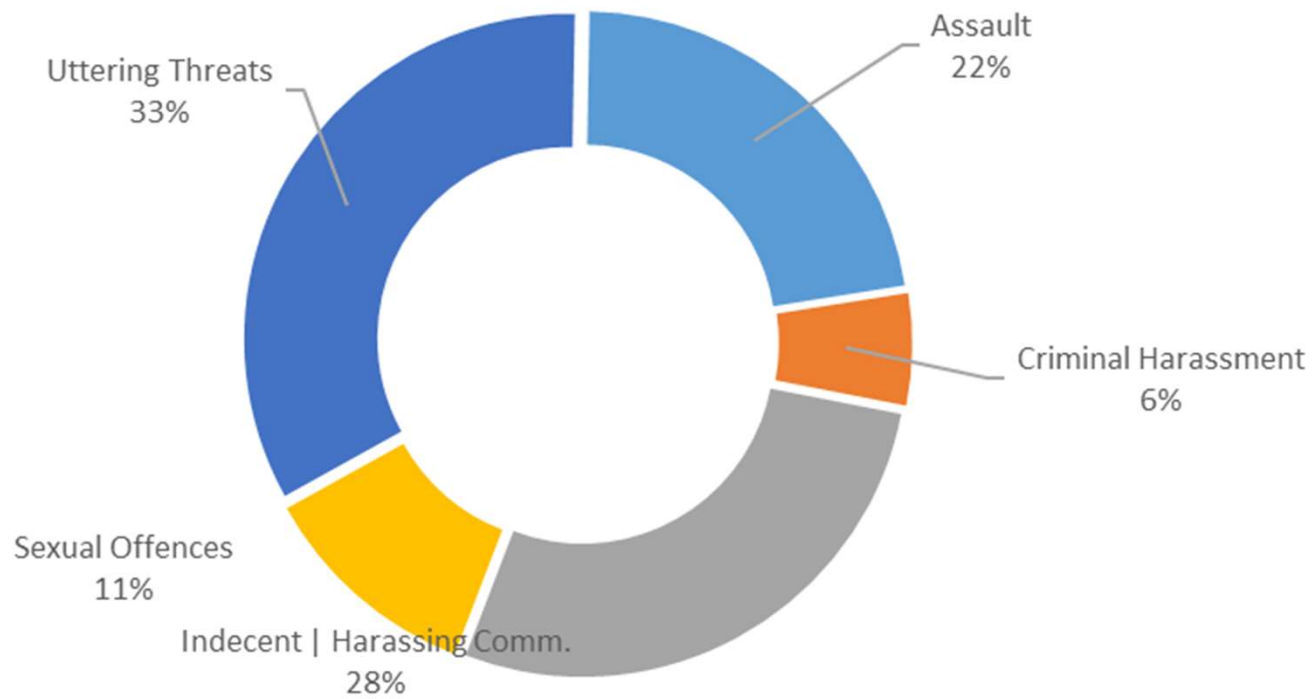

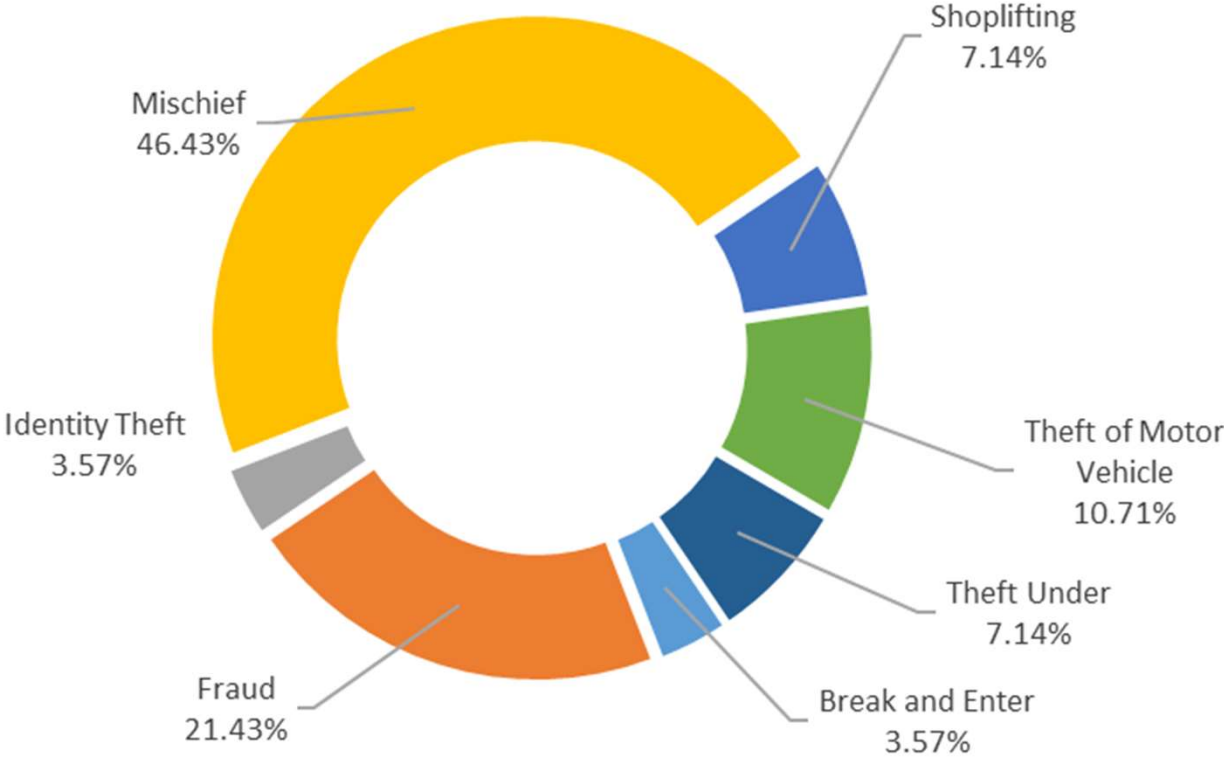

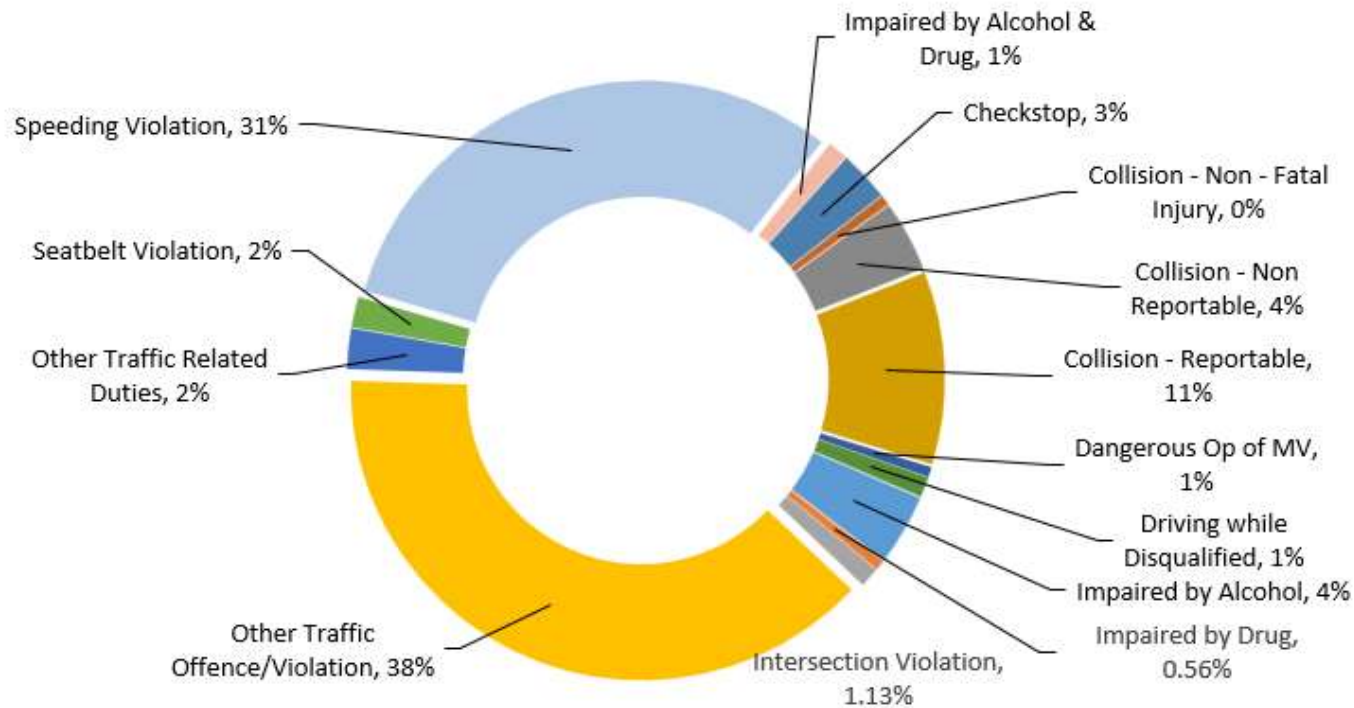

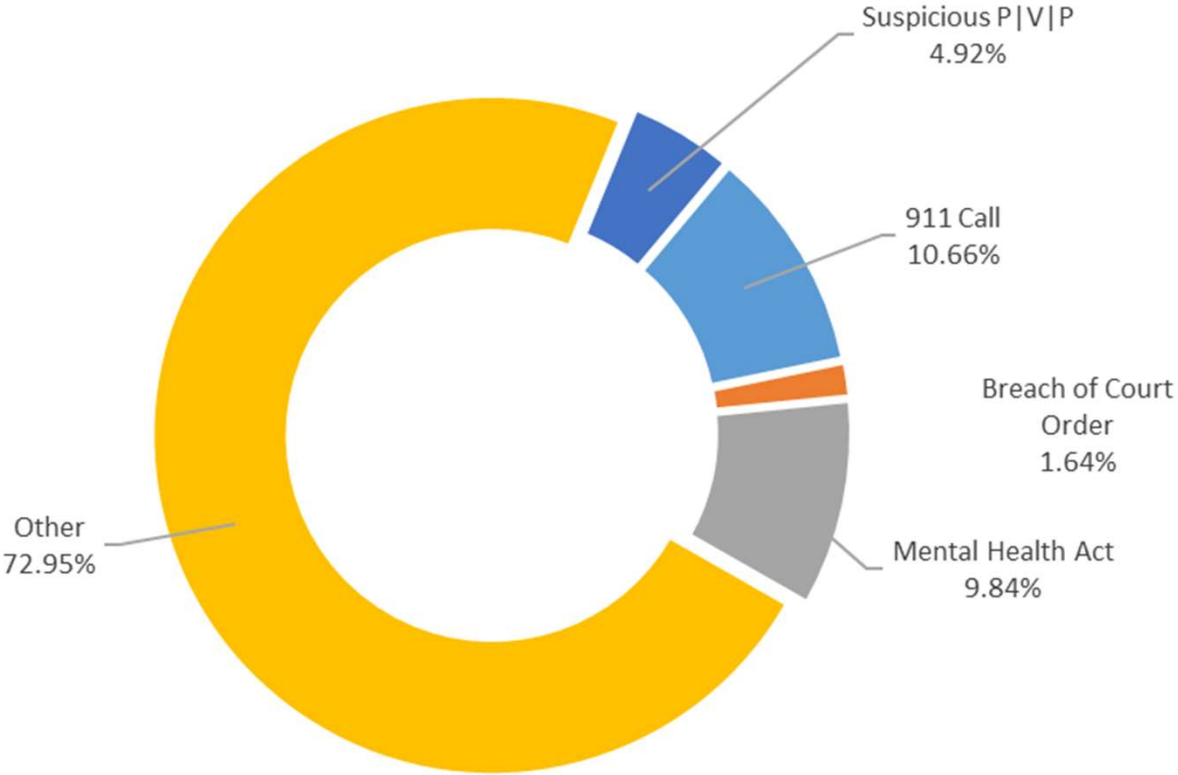
