Police Activity

Occurrence Summary

Persons crime remained consistent with January and higher than last February, ending the month with 26 occurrences (compared with 28 for January and 14 for last month). Assault was the most frequent type reported with 8 (6 of these being cleared), followed by indecent/harassing communications (7) and sexual offences (6). Two of the sexual offences were sextortion cases, with the complainant declining to proceed in one.

At 26, property crime levels were comparable with last month (28) and higher than last February (15). There were 10 mischief, 6 Theft Under \$5000 and 5 fraud incidents.

There were 2 drug enforcement occurrences opened in February. This is consistent with both last month and last year (0 and 1 respectively). Both involved reports of drug possession.

Traffic occurrences accounted for most of the incidents recorded in February, with 141 incidents. This is up from both last year (118) and down from last month (177). Month-over decreases in speeding (-19) and "other" traffic violations (-18) accounted for much of the month-over change. Seven impaired driving occurrences were reported, 4 by alcohol, 2 by drug, and 1 by a combination of alcohol and drugs. Of these, 5 were cleared by charge / charge recommended. There were 32 collisions reported, of which one involve a fatality. Four Checkstops were documented.

Overall, 354 occurrences were recorded with 344 of these being founded or still under investigation. This is consistent with last month, with 354 occurrences, of which 345 were founded/SUI. The month is higher than February 2026 (269 occurrences/ 259 founded/SUI) and lower than the 12-month average for the District (404 occurrences/ 389 founded/SUI).



Community Policing

Policing Initiatives

In February Kings Members responded to and partnered with Workers Compensation occupational health and safety officers for a workplace fatality in Orwell Cove and determined the occurrence was work-related and not criminal. Kings RCMP also attended a fatal pedestrian collision in Montague as a result of an encounter with a semi-truck. Additional first response agencies also attended including IEMS and Montague Fire Department, the investigation remains ongoing. A subject charged with a vehicle theft in Montague in January, that was used to collide with convenience store in Mount Stewart, was arrested for breaching probation. An individual was convicted of violent crime against another person as well as the responding police in Head of Hillsborough, and received 100 days jail. Another individual was convicted of impaired driving and refusal to provide a breath sample in Montague and received a 5 day jail sentence. Finally, a third person was convicted of Harassing Communications for repeated incidents that occurred in Georgetown Royalty where a term of 18 months probation was ordered. A disqualified driver was located in Brudenell, and Impaired drivers were detected in Vernon Bridge, Cherry Valley, Eldon, Baldwin road and Montague. Kings RCMP also partnered with Parole in Mount Stewart and electronic monitoring for individuals in Murray Harbour and Chepstow-who was found non-compliant. Finally, two employees received supervisor training and another advanced skills in medical response.

Traffic Enforcement

Checkstops were completed in Kinross (Feb 8), Baldwins Road and Victoria Cross (Feb 27) Souris and Cardigan (Feb 26) – Nearly 250 vehicles were checked, summary offence tickets and warnings were issued in addition to select focus on snowmobiles where several mandatory breath samples were taken resulting in no alcohol impairment detection.

- Feb 2 and 15 - Route 2, Souris – Focus on speed. Warnings were issued.
- Feb 8 – Route 2, Morell and in Lake Verde – Focus on speed.
- Feb 15 – Main Street Souris – General traffic enforcement. Warnings issued
- Feb 17 – Lyndale – Focus on speed.
- Feb 25 – Route 4, Vernon River and Bridgetown – General traffic enforcement. Warnings issued for a variety of offences.
- Feb 27 – Main Street Montague – General traffic enforcement.

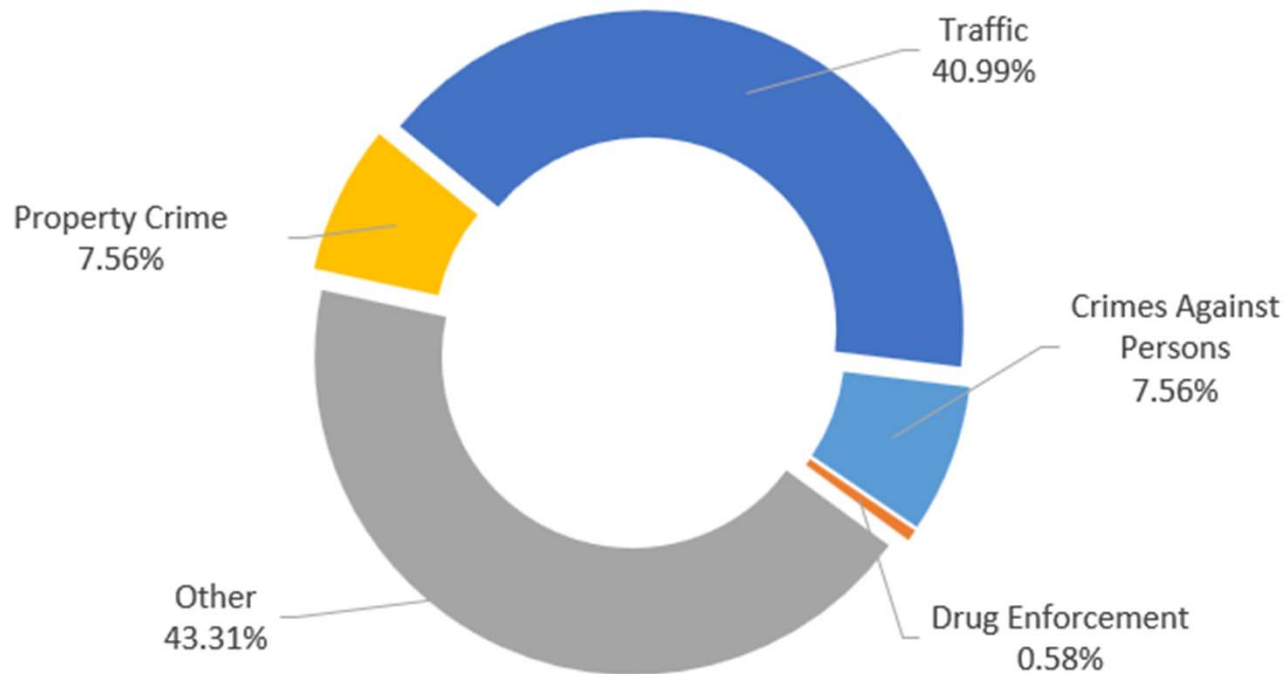

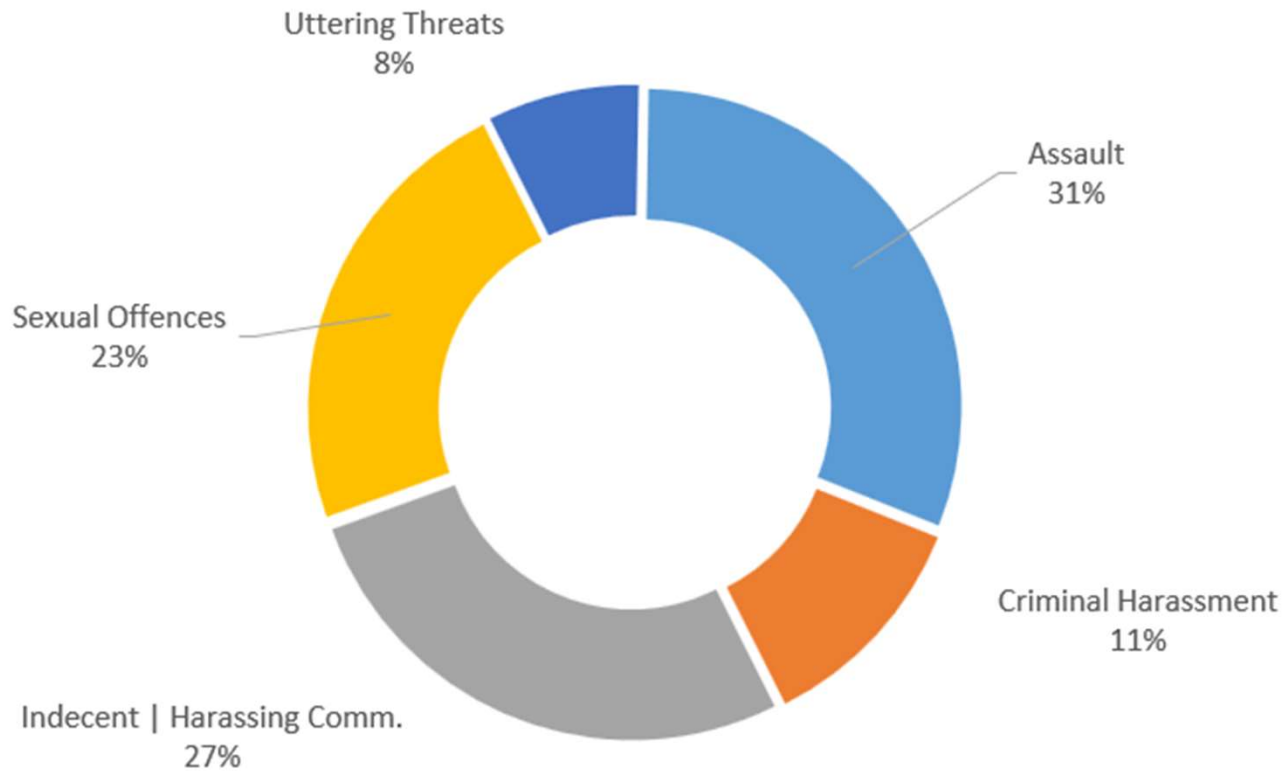

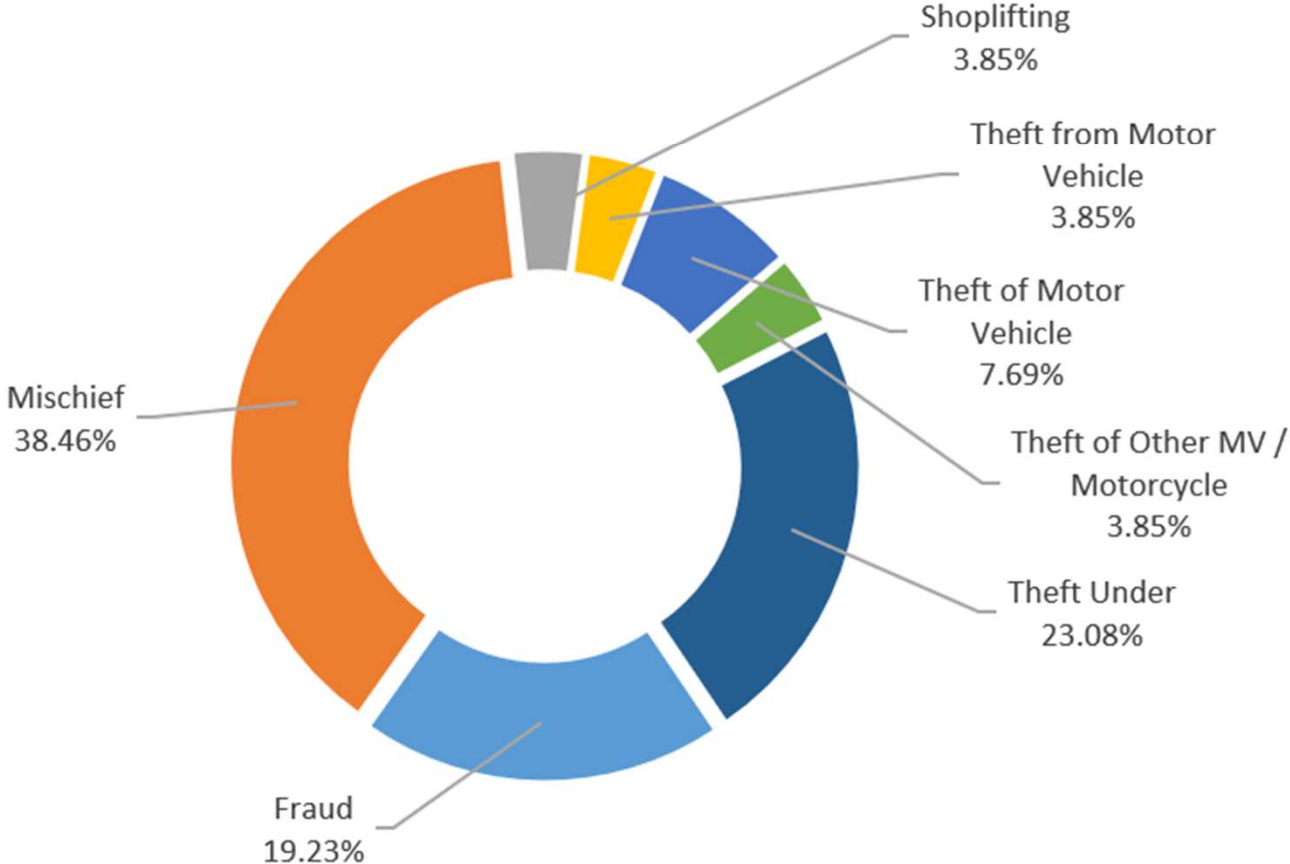

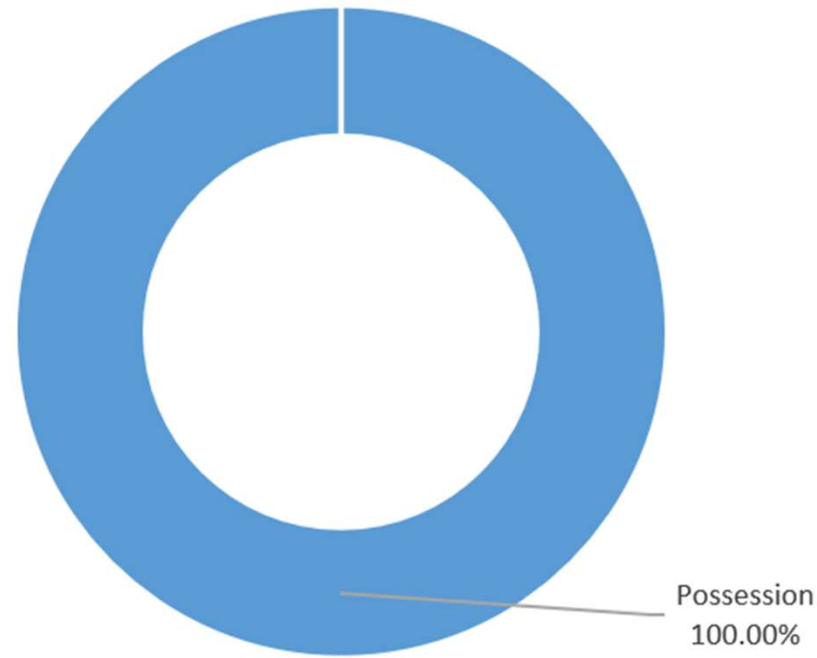

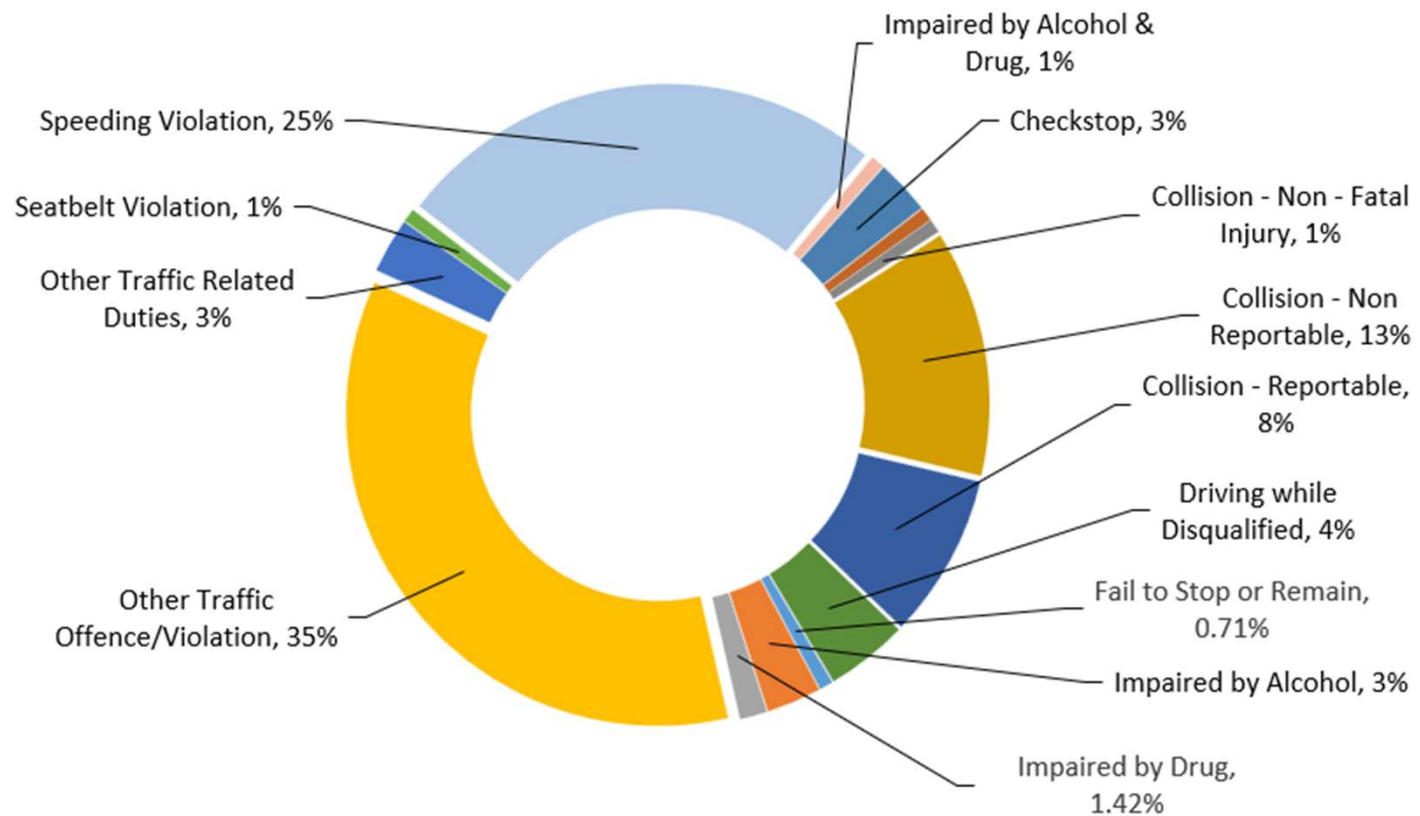

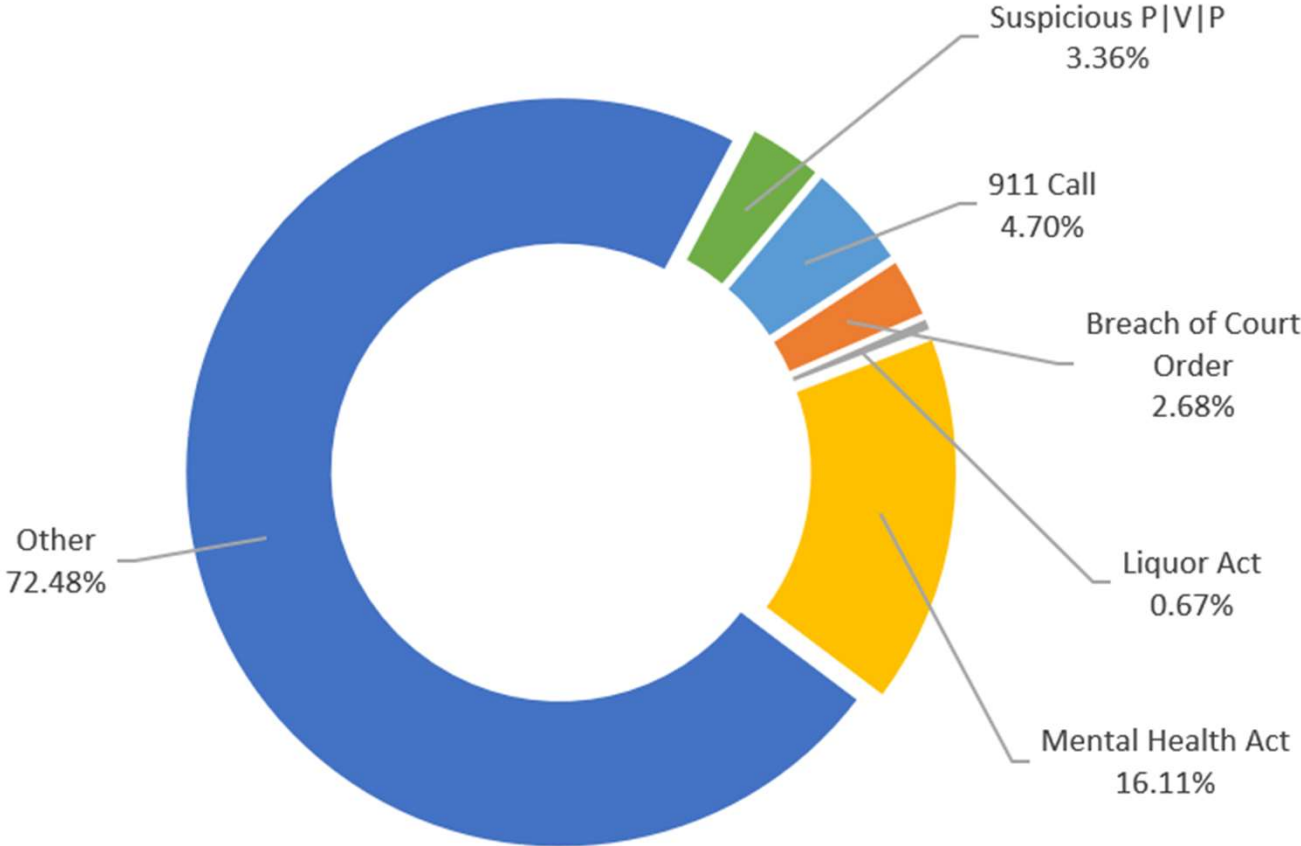
