Police Activity

Occurrence Summary

Persons crime remained consistent both February and last March, ending the month with 21 occurrences, compared with 26 for last month and 22 for last year. Indecent/harassing communication incidents were reported most frequently with 7, followed by assault (6) and utter threats (4).

At 32, property crime levels were comparable with last month (26) and lower than last March (44). There were 16 mischief, 6 fraud and 4 Theft Under \$5000 incidents.

There was one drug enforcement occurrence opened in March. This is consistent with both last month and last year (2 and 1 respectively). It is still under investigation.

Traffic occurrences accounted for most of the incidents recorded in March, with 142 incidents. This is the same level as last month (143) and marginally lower than last year (152). Five impaired driving occurrences were reported, 4 by alcohol and 1 by drug. Of these, 4 were cleared by charge / charge recommended. There were 20 collisions reported, none of which involve fatalities. Seven Checkstops were documented.

Overall, 321 occurrences were recorded with 315 of these being founded or still under investigation. This is consistent with last month, with 358 occurrences, of which 348 were founded/SUI and with last year where 355 occurrences were reported with 338 founded/SUI. The month is lower than the 12-month average for the District (412 occurrences/ 396 founded/SUI).



Community Policing

Policing Initiatives

In March Kings RCMP Members, Provincial units and the Emergency Response Team executed multiple search warrants in both Kings and Queens counties, resulting in several individuals being arrested for firearms and drug offences. In Greenfield, Kings RCMP investigated a road rage incident where an individual was assaulted with a baseball bat, this led to multiple arrests and charges being laid. RCMP Members responded to a report of a house fire in Elmira where it was reported that someone was trapped - this turned out to be unfounded. RCMP also responded to a call in Murray River advising a young person was going to jump off a bridge, members were able to de-escalate the situation and worked with partnering agencies to get this person the appropriate treatment. Members were dispatched to be what appeared to be a serious crime in Montague, which turned into a missing person investigation over the next two days, which then led to an arrest and apprehension of the same individual. RCMP investigated a suspicious house fire in Glenwilliam which led to a seizure of illegal firearms, partnering with several agencies including the Office of the Fire Commissioner and Firearms office. RCMP members were also dispatched to a call in Montague regarding an individual holding what appeared to be a firearm and making threatening comments to another person. The photo turned out to have been altered using AI, however the individual was charged with related offenses and has an upcoming court appearance.

Selective Traffic Enforcement Program

Checkstops were completed in Souris (Mar 2, 3), Peakes (Mar 10), Victoria (Mar 10), Lake Verde (Mar 12), Victoria Cross (Mar 12), Glenwilliam (Mar 19), Elliottvale (Mar 19), Auburn (Mar 19) - over 225 vehicles were checked and summary offence tickets and warnings were issued.

- March 02 - Route 1, Orwell – Speed enforcement, 1 warning issued
- March 03 – Route 210, Victoria Cross – General traffic enforcement. No violators noted
- Provincial Traffic unit conducted 17 dedicated patrols in Three Rivers and 9 in Souris

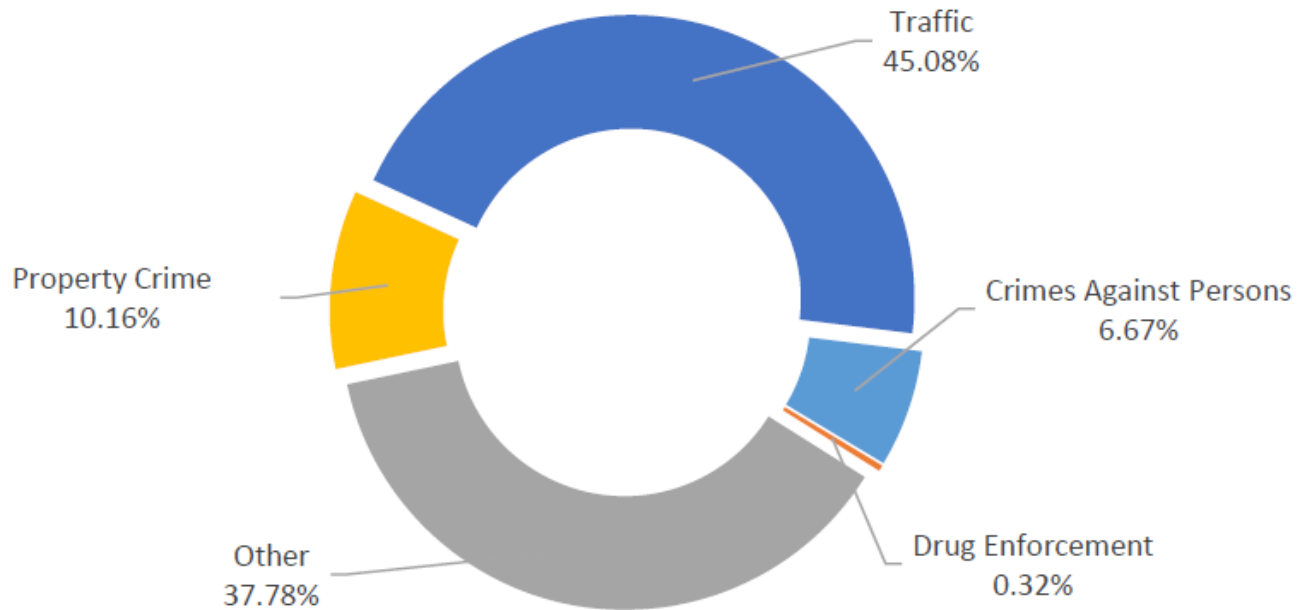

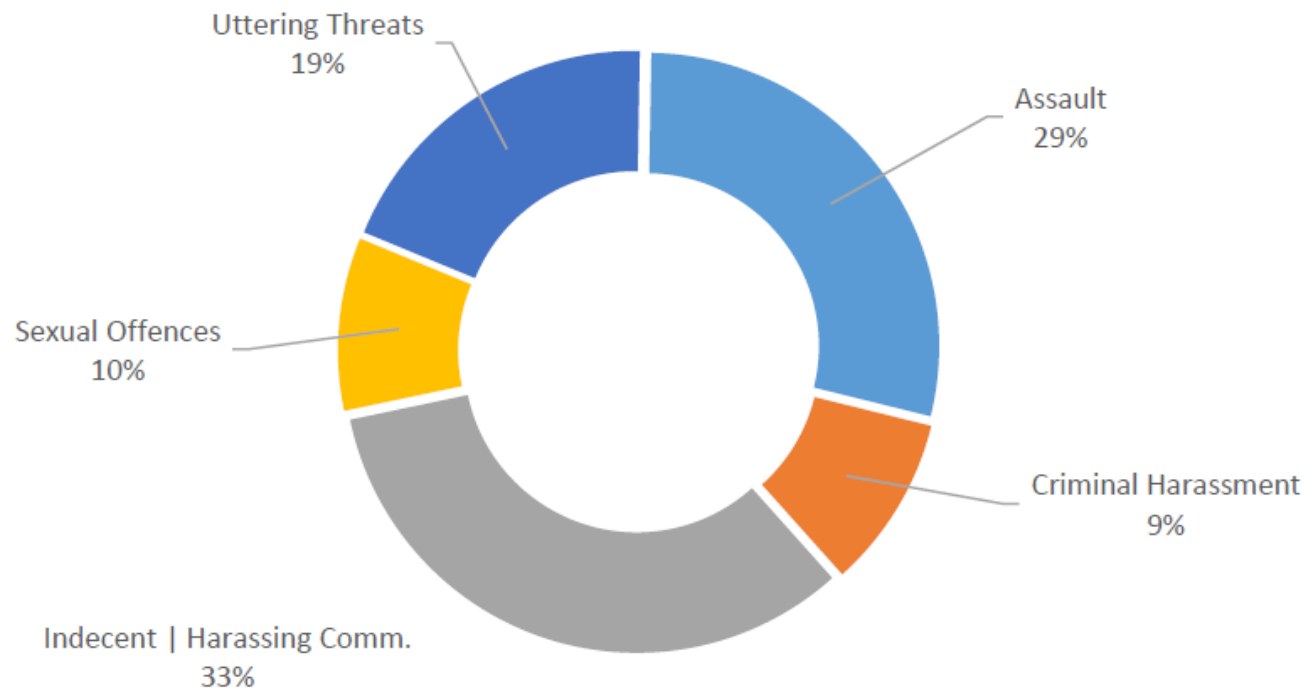

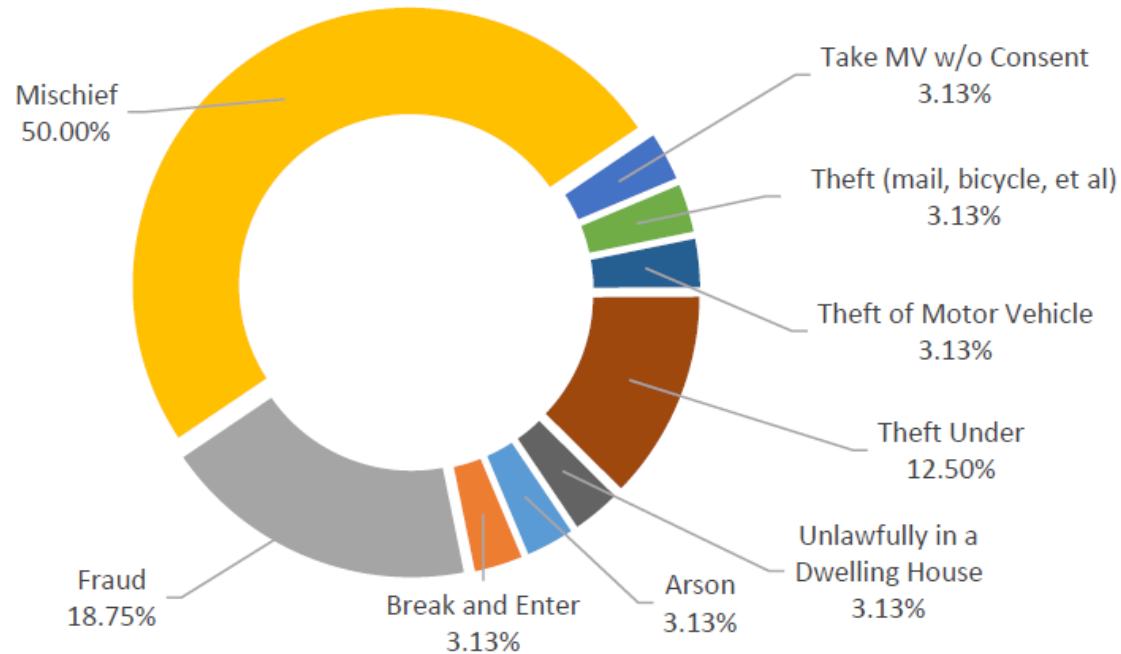

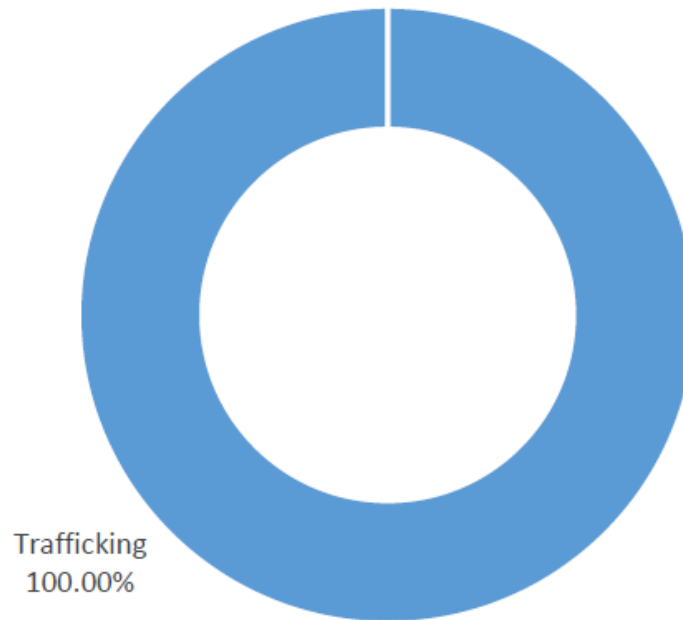

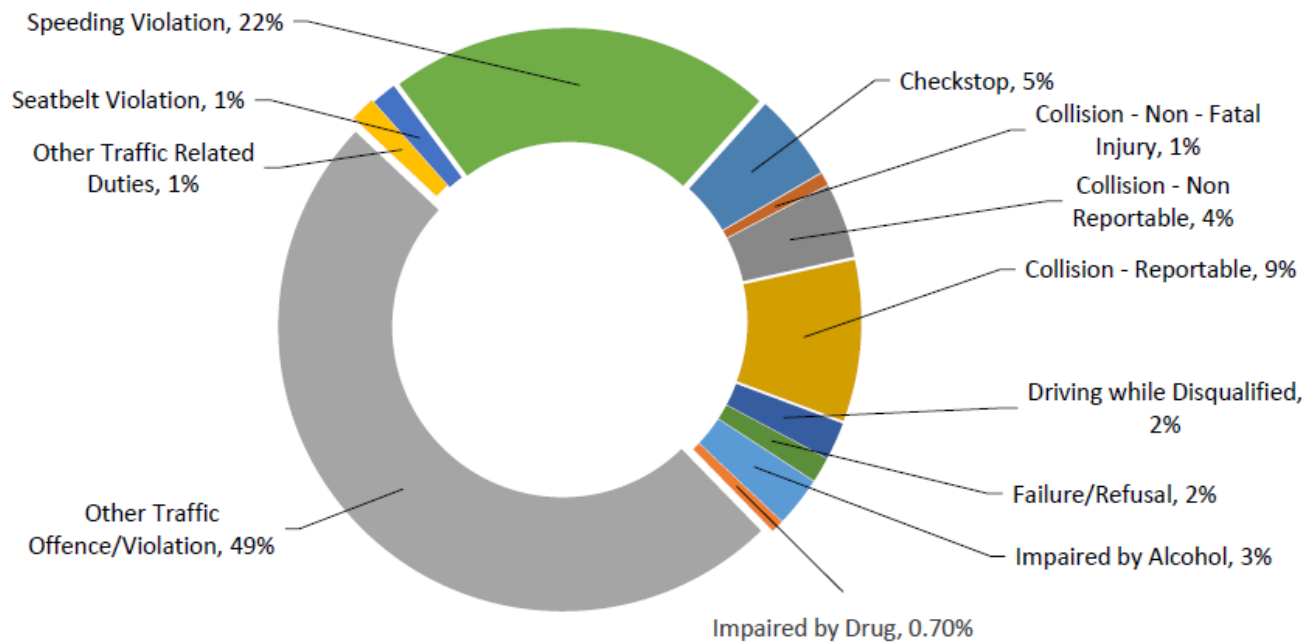

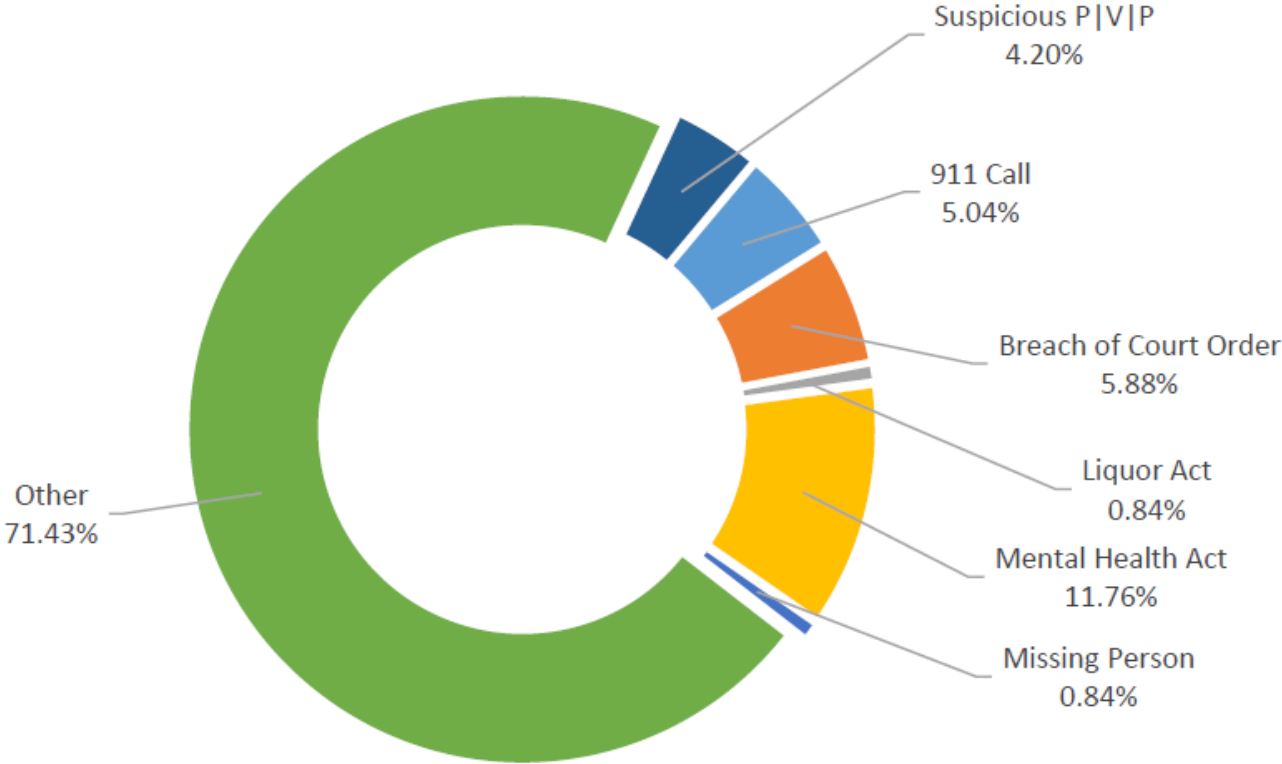
